

# **LRYHA FUNDRAISING POLICY**

## **2007-2008**

This policy sets forth the Association's position and the player's obligation to fulfill their fundraising responsibilities to LRYHA.

### **BUDGET:**

As a part of its annual budget, the Executive Committee shall develop estimated revenue to be derived from fundraising. Fundraising activities shall be coordinated by the Fundraising Chairman and administered on a team-by-team basis by team managers.

### **COMMITMENT:**

The following is a list of fundraising obligations per player for the 2007-2008 season:

- Travel Teams - \$200
- Instructional - \$150
- In House - \$50
- LTS - \$0
- Split Season Midgets - \$0

Please note that the main fundraiser for this season will again be a calendar sale. Players may opt out of participating in the fundraiser by paying the following amounts at the time of registration:

- Travel Teams - \$150
- Instructional - \$100
- In House - \$40

### **PROCESS:**

The Fundraising Chairman shall coordinate all activities with the team managers. The managers will be responsible for distribution of fundraising materials and collection of revenues. The managers shall notify the Coach, Fundraising Chairman and Vice-President of any players who do not fill their fundraising commitment by the due date.

### **SCHEDULE:**

The Board of Directors recognizes the expensive nature of youth hockey. To facilitate access to the program to all Lakes Region youth, the following fundraising schedule is hereby established:

Number of Calendars: Travel Team – 20, Instructional – 15, In-House – 5  
(\$10 per calendar)

To be distributed in November 2007, due back in January 2008

**Players who do not fulfill their fundraising obligations by the due date will be removed from the ice until such time as their commitment has been completed.**
